Essential part of the field report narrative</li> </ol>	<u>Scientific Visualizations</u> Truth Claim: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1-An “authentic” visualization, often interactive of the important engines of change in a system.</li> <li>2-Based on Empirical result</li> <li>3- Drives empirical Questions</li> </ol>	<u>Educational Research Visualizations</u> Truth Claims: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1-An authentic visualization, however the camera and crew are present with the PI and the shooting may order and arrange classroom settings</li> <li>2- Demonstrates the engines of change in an innovation.</li> <li>2-Based on empirical results</li> <li>3- accurate enough to persuade, be used as a warrant.</li> <li>4-Well suited to the Learning Science research</li> </ol>

Uses critical theory, and film theory language. <b>Sergei Mikhailovich Eisenstein</b> said most of what is important 100 years ago	<b>Creation of Language</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1-Each science domain uses very different forms of visualization.</li> <li>2-Some forms of visualization are difficult for new learners</li> <li>3-Common forms between domains are limited.</li> </ol>	<b>Change in the Narrative form</b> More of a process narrative, e.g. Sci Vi, and less of a story telling narrative with an emotional arc as in Ethnographic Film.
